Can anyone nominate a project or charity?

Unfortunately not. Nominations can only be made by Superannuation Advice Australia clients.

How much does the winner receive?

The worthy winner will receive a donation of up to \$20,000 from the Superannuation Advice Community Fund.

How do I vote?

You will be able to vote for the final shortlisted projects across our social channels. Voting will only be open for two weeks at a time, so make sure you keep an eye out.

Can anyone vote & can I vote more than once?

Yes, voting is open to everyone and you will be able to vote across our social channels. Make sure you tell your friends and family to cast their votes as well.

Do nominations need to be a registered charity or business?

All nominated projects and charities must be eligible Deductible Gift Recipients. Please refer to the Australian Government Business Register for further information and to check your project or charity.

How do you decide on who is shortlisted?

Our review panel will shortlist nominations based on their ability to strengthen their local community, as well as the charities ability to bring the local community together as part of their plans. We will also ensure that the proposed plans are realistic & achievable with the funds available.
